- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Education
- 15 **7–203.5**.
- 16 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ASSESSMENT" MEANS A LOCALLY, STATE, OR
- 17 FEDERALLY MANDATED TEST THAT IS INTENDED TO MEASURE A STUDENT'S
- 18 ACADEMIC READINESS, LEARNING PROGRESS, AND SKILL ACQUISITION.
- 19 (2) "ASSESSMENT" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TEACHER-DEVELOPED
- 20 QUIZ OR TEST.
- 21 (B) THE PARTNERSHIP FOR ASSESSMENT OF READINESS FOR COLLEGE
- 22 AND CAREERS ASSESSMENT MAY NOT BE ADMINISTERED IN THE STATE.

- 1 (C) BEGINNING IN THE 2018–2019 SCHOOL YEAR, THE CALIFORNIA 2 ACHIEVEMENT TEST SHALL BE ADMINISTERED AS AN ASSESSMENT THAT SATISFIES 3 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  $5\,$  1, 2018.
