CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commercial Driver's Licenses – Recognition, Prevention, and Reporting of**
3 **Human Trafficking**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to include questions on
5 human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting as part of the
6 commercial driver's license knowledge test; requiring commercial driver's license
7 training schools to include training on human trafficking recognition, prevention,
8 and effective reporting as part of the curriculum; requiring the Administration to
9 include content on human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting
10 in its Commercial Driver's License Manual; requiring the Administration to provide
11 content on human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting from
12 the Manual to applicants renewing their commercial driver's licenses; and generally
13 relating to commercial driver's licenses.

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Transportation**

6 16–807.

7 (b) (1) Except as provided in § 16–807.1 of this subtitle, an individual may not
8 be issued a commercial driver’s license until the individual has passed the knowledge and
9 skill tests for driving a commercial motor vehicle which complies with the minimum federal
10 standards established by the federal Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 (Title
11 XII of Public Law 99–570), and has satisfied all other requirements of that act as well as
12 any other requirements of this title.

13 (2) The tests shall be prescribed and conducted at the direction of the
14 Administration **AND, IN ADDITION TO FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS, SHALL INCLUDE**
15 **QUESTIONS ON THE RECOGNITION, PREVENTION, AND EFFECTIVE REPORTING OF**
16 **HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

17 (3) The Administration shall adopt regulations to waive the skill test
18 required under paragraph (1) of this subsection in a manner consistent with 49 C.F.R. §
19 383.77.

21 **(A) A COMMERCIAL DRIVER’S LICENSE TRAINING SCHOOL SHALL INCLUDE**
22 **AS PART OF ITS CURRICULUM EDUCATION AND TRAINING ON THE RECOGNITION,**
23 **PREVENTION, AND EFFECTIVE REPORTING OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

24 **(B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:**

25 **(1) INCLUDE AS PART OF ITS COMMERCIAL DRIVER’S LICENSE**
26 **MANUAL CONTENT ON THE RECOGNITION, PREVENTION, AND EFFECTIVE**
27 **REPORTING OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING; AND**

28 **(2) ON REQUEST, PROVIDE TO AN APPLICANT RENEWING A**
29 **COMMERCIAL DRIVER’S LICENSE CONTENT FROM THE MANUAL ON THE**
30 **RECOGNITION, PREVENTION, AND EFFECTIVE REPORTING OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 October 1, 2018.
