- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to include questions on 5 human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting as part of the 6 commercial driver's license knowledge test; requiring commercial driver's license 7 training schools to include training on human trafficking recognition, prevention, 8 and effective reporting as part of the curriculum; requiring the Administration to 9 include content on human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting 10 in its Commercial Driver's License Manual; requiring the Administration to provide 11 content on human trafficking recognition, prevention, and effective reporting from the Manual to applicants renewing their commercial driver's licenses; and generally 12 13 relating to commercial driver's licenses.
