E4, C5 8lr2982 By: Delegate McComas Introduced and read first time: February 9, 2018 Assigned to: Economic Matters Committee Report: Favorable with amendments House action: Adopted Read second time: March 13, 2018 CHAPTER AN ACT concerning Public Safety - Solar Photovoltaic Systems - Lockout Tag Requirement FOR the purpose of requiring a company that installs solar photovoltaic systems to install a certain lockout tag containing a safety warning under certain circumstances; requiring a certain company to provide a certain customer with a certain lockout tage for a solar photovoltaic system that has previously been installed; providing for the enforcement of this Act; establishing a penalty for certain violations of this Act; specifying that a local government shall retain certain funds; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to safety warnings for solar photovoltaic installations. BY adding to Article – Public Safety Section 12–705 Annotated Code of Maryland (2011 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
