- 29 (2) A SOCIAL ORGANIZATION GRANTED A LICENSE UNDER THIS 30 SECTION MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, FROM 4 P.M. TO 11 P.M.
