7 ~~and, to the extent practicable, reflect a certain diversity; requiring the Committee to~~
8 ~~establish a certain Action Task Force subcommittee; requiring the Action Task Force~~
9 ~~subcommittee to have a certain membership; requiring the Action Task Force~~
10 ~~subcommittee to analyze certain factors, examine the impact of certain factors on~~
11 ~~maternal deaths, review and make certain recommendations, and play a certain role~~

11 WHEREAS, Maternal deaths are a key indicator of the health of residents of the
 12 State, as well as the status of social and economic development in the State; and

13 WHEREAS, The United States ranks 60th in the world for maternal mortality,
 14 behind all other developed nations; and

15 WHEREAS, Maryland ranks 38th in the nation for maternal mortality; and

16 WHEREAS, Maryland established a Maternal Mortality Review Committee in 2000
 17 to identify maternal death cases, review medical records, determine the preventability of
 18 maternal deaths, and make recommendations for the prevention of maternal deaths; and

19 WHEREAS, The State's maternal mortality rate has increased 51% when comparing
 20 the review period of 2010 to 2014 with the review period of 2005 to 2009; and

21 WHEREAS, The Maternal Mortality Review Committee has found that most of the
 22 maternal deaths that have occurred have been preventable; and

23 WHEREAS, The State, with the leadership of the Maternal Mortality Review
 24 ~~Committee and support of the Action Task Force Program~~, needs to identify ways to prevent
 25 maternal deaths; and

26 WHEREAS, The time has come for Maryland to act to save the lives of mothers; now,
 27 therefore,

28 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

(A) On or before December 1 of each year, the Secretary shall submit a report on
findings, recommendations, and Program actions to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246
of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.

(B) THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER
SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION A SUMMARY OF ANY STAKEHOLDER MEETINGS
HELD UNDER § 13-1208 OF THIS SUBTITLE DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING
12-MONTH PERIOD THAT INCLUDES:

(1) STAKEHOLDER RESPONSES TO EXISTING RECOMMENDATIONS;

AND

(2) RECOMMENDATIONS FROM STAKEHOLDERS THAT ADDRESS
FACTORS CONTRIBUTING TO MATERNAL MORTALITY.

(A) AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, THE SECRETARY SHALL CONVENE A MEETING
OF STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES OF:

DISPARITIES;

(2) THE MARYLAND PATIENT SAFETY CENTER;

(3) THE MARYLAND HEAD START PROGRAM;

(4) WOMEN'S HEALTH ADVOCACY ORGANIZATIONS;

1 **(5) COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS ENGAGED IN MATERNAL HEALTH**
2 **AND FAMILY SUPPORT ISSUES;**

3 **(6) FAMILIES THAT HAVE EXPERIENCED A MATERNAL DEATH;**

4 **(7) LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS; AND**

5 **(8) HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT PROVIDE MATERNAL HEALTH**
6 **SERVICES.**

7 **(B) OF THE TWO MEETINGS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS**

9 **(1) ONE MEETING SHALL BE HELD WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER**
10 **SUBMISSION OF THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER § 13-1207 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO:**

11 **(I) REVIEW THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS IN THE**
12 **REPORT;**

13 **(II) EXAMINE ISSUES RESULTING IN DISPARITIES IN MATERNAL**
14 **DEATHS;**

15 **(III) REVIEW THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF PREVIOUS**
16 **RECOMMENDATIONS; AND**

17 **(IV) IDENTIFY NEW RECOMMENDATIONS WITH A FOCUS ON**
18 **INITIATIVES TO ADDRESS ISSUES RESULTING IN DISPARITIES IN MATERNAL DEATHS;**

20 **(2) ONE MEETING SHALL BE HELD WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE**
21 **MEETING HELD UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO REVIEW THE STATUS OF**
22 **IMPLEMENTATION OF PREVIOUS RECOMMENDATIONS AND CONSIDER ANY NEW**
23 **INFORMATION THAT MAY BE RELEVANT FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF ADDITIONAL**
24 **RECOMMENDATIONS.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
26 1, 2018.
