- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Tax General
- 14 **11–234.**
- The sales and use tax does not apply to the sale of a Bluetooth
- 16 HEADSET OR A CONSUMER ELECTRONIC DEVICE DESIGNED TO AID IN HANDS-FREE
- 17 DEVICE USE WHILE DRIVING IF THE TAXABLE PRICE OF THE HEADSET OR DEVICE
- 18 DOES NOT EXCEED \$500.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 20 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2021,
- 21 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and
- 22 of no further force and effect.
