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Maryland Office for Refugees and Asylees – Placement Information (Unaccompanied Alien Children Placement Transparency Act)

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Office for Refugees and Asylees to request 5 annually a report from the Office of Refugee Resettlement in the United States 6 Department of Health and Human Services containing certain information on 7 unaccompanied alien children placed with sponsors in the State; requiring the Office, 8 subject to a certain restriction, to provide a de-identified, aggregate version of the 9 information to certain county entities within a certain time period; requiring the Office, to the extent possible and consistent with certain laws, to provide information 10 11 relating to children in a county to certain entities in that county; prohibiting the 12 Office from releasing certain individual—level or potentially identifiable information; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Maryland Office of Refugees 13 14 and Asylees.

- 24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OFFICE" MEANS THE MARYLAND OFFICE FOR 25 REFUGEES AND ASYLEES IN THE DEPARTMENT.

1	(B) THE OFFICE SHALL REQUEST ANNUALLY A REPORT FROM THE OFFICE
2	OF REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT IN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
3	AND HUMAN SERVICES THAT CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR EACH
4	UNACCOMPANIED ALIEN CHILD WHO HAS BEEN PLACED WITH A SPONSOR IN THE
5	STATE:
6	(1) THE CHILD'S MEDICAL RECORDS, IF THE CHILD IS ATTENDING A
7	PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE STATE;
8	(2) THE SPONSOR'S ADDRESS AND IMMIGRATION STATUS;
9	(3) ANY FEDERAL PUBLIC BENEFIT THE CHILD RECEIVES; AND
10	(4) ANY FEDERAL PUBLIC BENEFIT THE SPONSOR RECEIVES AS A
11	RESULT OF SPONSORSHIP.
12	(C) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WITHIN 60
13	DAYS AFTER RECEIVING INFORMATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION
14	THE OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE A DE-IDENTIFIED, AGGREGATE VERSION OF THE
15	INFORMATION TO THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES IN EACH COUNTY WHERE AN
16	UNACCOMPANIED ALIEN CHILD HAS BEEN PLACED:
17	(I) THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY;
18	(II) THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; AND
19	(III) THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.
20	(2) (I) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE AND CONSISTENT WITH FEDERAL
21	AND STATE PRIVACY LAWS, THE OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION RELATING
22	TO CHILDREN PLACED IN A COUNTY TO THE SPECIFIED ENTITIES IN THAT COUNTY.
23	(II) THE OFFICE MAY NOT RELEASE INDIVIDUAL-LEVEL OR
24	POTENTIALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION UNDER THIS SECTION.
