2 Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Telemedicine – Assertive Community
3 Treatment and Mobile Treatment Services

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health, under certain 5 circumstances, to include psychiatrists who are providing Assertive Community 6 Treatment or mobile treatment services to certain Maryland Medical Assistance 7 Program recipients in the types of providers eligible to receive reimbursement for 8 health care services that are delivered through telemedicine and provided to 9 Program recipients; providing that a certain health care service provided through telemedicine by a certain psychiatrist is equivalent to the same health care service 10 11 when provided through an in-person consultation for a certain purpose; and 12 generally relating to the Maryland Medical Assistance Program and telemedicine.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 22 (a) The Program shall reimburse health care providers in accordance with the 23 requirements of Title 19, Subtitle 1, Part IV of this article.
- 24 (b) (1) (i) In this subsection the following words have the meanings 25 indicated.

"Health care provider" means a person who is licensed, certified, 1 (ii) 2 or otherwise authorized under the Health Occupations Article to provide health care in the 3 ordinary course of business or practice of a profession or in an approved education or training program. 4 "Telemedicine" means, as it relates to the delivery of 5 1. 6 health care services, the use of interactive audio, video, or other telecommunications or 7 electronic technology: 8 Α. By a health care provider to deliver a health care service 9 that is within the scope of practice of the health care provider at a site other than the site 10 at which the patient is located; and 11 В. That enables the patient to see and interact with the 12 health care provider at the time the health care service is provided to the patient. 13 2. "Telemedicine" does not include: 14 An audio-only telephone conversation between a health 15 care provider and a patient; 16 В. An electronic mail message between a health care provider 17 and a patient; or C. 18 A facsimile transmission between a health care provider 19 and a patient. 20 To the extent authorized by federal law or regulation, the provisions of 21§ 15–139(c) through (f) of the Insurance Article relating to coverage of and reimbursement 22for health care services delivered through telemedicine shall apply to the Program and 23managed care organizations in the same manner they apply to carriers. 24Subject to the limitations of the State budget and to the extent (3)25authorized by federal law or regulation, the Department may authorize coverage of and 26 reimbursement for health care services that are delivered through store and forward 27 technology or remote patient monitoring. 28 The Department may specify by regulation the types of health care providers eligible to receive reimbursement for health care services provided to 29 30 Program recipients under this subsection. 31 If the Department specifies by regulation the types of health care 32 providers eligible to receive reimbursement for health care services provided to Program 33 recipients under this subsection, the types of health care providers specified shall include

## 1. PRIMARY care providers; AND

- 2. PSYCHIATRISTS WHO ARE PROVIDING ASSERTIVE 3 COMMUNITY TREATMENT OR MOBILE TREATMENT SERVICES TO PROGRAM 4 RECIPIENTS LOCATED IN A HOME OR COMMUNITY-BASED SETTING.
- 5 (III) FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSEMENT AND ANY FIDELITY
  6 STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT, A HEALTH CARE SERVICE
  7 PROVIDED THROUGH TELEMEDICINE BY A PSYCHIATRIST DESCRIBED UNDER
  8 SUBPARAGRAPH (II)2 OF THIS PARAGRAPH IS EQUIVALENT TO THE SAME HEALTH
  9 CARE SERVICE WHEN PROVIDED THROUGH AN IN-PERSON CONSULTATION.
- 10 (5) The Department may require a health care provider to submit a 11 registration form to the Department that includes information required for the processing 12 of claims for reimbursement for health care services provided to Program recipients under 13 this subsection.
- 14 (6) The Department shall adopt regulations to carry out this subsection.
