A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Teachers and Teacher Preparation Programs – Maryland Reading Standards Matrix – Established

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, the University System 4 5 of Maryland, and the Maryland Higher Education Commission to develop a 6 Maryland Reading Standards Matrix on or before a certain date; requiring the 7 Maryland Reading Standards Matrix to reflect certain standards and research; 8 requiring the Department, the System, and the Commission to develop a certain 9 syllabus and timeline for certain faculty and to establish a certain accreditation process for certain programs; requiring a certain course to include certain 10 11 components; requiring certain programs to use the Maryland Reading Standards 12 Matrix to develop certain courses and syllabi and deliver certain instruction; defining 13 certain terms; and generally relating to the Maryland Reading Standards Matrix.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15 That:
- 16 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (2) "Accrediting body" means a body that specializes in the knowledge and 18 practice that teachers of reading need to know and be able to do to teach all students to 19 read proficiently, including students with reading difficulties and dyslexia.
- 20 (3) "Pre—service educator preparation" is the education and training 21 provided to student teachers before they have undertaken any teaching.
 - (b) (1) On or before March 1, 2019, the State Department of Education, the University System of Maryland, and the Maryland Higher Education Commission shall, in consultation with literacy educators, dyslexia advocacy organizations, district—level teacher training specialists and supervisors, the International Dyslexia Association, and Decoding Dyslexia Maryland, develop a Maryland Reading Standards Matrix.



$\frac{1}{2}$	(2) The Maryland Reading Standards Matrix shall reflect the most recenversion of:
3 4	(i) the International Literacy Association Standards for the Preparation of Literacy;
5 6	(ii) the International Dyslexia Association Knowledge and Practic Standards for Teachers of Reading;
7	(iii) current research on the science of reading;
8	(iv) standards from the Maryland Reading Course Workgroup; and
9	(v) Maryland College and Career–Ready Standards.
10 11	(c) (1) On or before March 1, 2020, the State Department of Education, the University System of Maryland, and the Maryland Higher Education Commission shall:
12 13	(i) develop a syllabus and timeline to provide professional development courses for faculty who:
14 15	1. teach one or more of the required reading courses to pre-service educators and faculty who supervise pre-service educator internships; and
16 17 18	2. supervise pre–service educator internships to ensur faculty have the knowledge and practice to coach and mentor pre–service educators whos internship includes students at risk for reading difficulties, including dyslexia; and
19 20	(ii) establish an accreditation process for all undergraduate an graduate educator reading preparation programs in conjunction with an accrediting body
21 22	(2) The course shall include all the components of the Maryland Readin Standards Matrix.
23 24 25 26	(d) On or before July 1, 2020, all Maryland undergraduate and graduat pre–service educator preparation programs shall use the Maryland Reading Standard Matrix to develop reading courses and syllabi, and to deliver reading instruction to pre–service educator candidates

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June $28-1,\,2018.$
