## Public Safety - Rifles and Shotguns - Purchases

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering a provision of law to authorize a resident of this State who is 4 eligible to purchase a rifle or shotgun under the laws of another state to purchase a 5 rifle or shotgun from a certain dealer in the other state, instead of limiting the 6 purchase to an adjacent state; altering a provision of law to authorize a resident of 7 another state who is eligible to purchase a rifle or shotgun under the laws of this 8 State to purchase a rifle or shotgun from a certain dealer in this State, instead of 9 limiting the purchase to a resident of an adjacent state; repealing a certain definition; and generally relating to rifles and shotguns. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 20 (a) [In this section, "adjacent state" means Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, or 21 West Virginia.
- 22 (b)] If a resident of this State is eligible to purchase a rifle or shotgun under the
- 23 laws of [an adjacent] ANOTHER state, the resident may purchase a rifle or shotgun from a
- 24 federally licensed gun dealer in the [adjacent] OTHER state.



- [(c)] (B) If a resident of [an adjacent] ANOTHER state is eligible to purchase a rifle or shotgun under the laws of this State, the resident may purchase a rifle or shotgun from a federally licensed gun dealer in this State.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2018.
