 after an appeal to certain appeals filed with a supervisor of assessments on or after
 a certain date and still pending a final decision on or after a certain date; and

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 Article Tax Property
- 19 8–205.

20 (b) When conducting subsequent reassessments of the property, the supervisor or 21 the Department:

(1) may not automatically eliminate a reduction in the assessment of the
 property that was granted by a property tax assessment appeal board or the Maryland Tax

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2017, AND SHALL BE APPLICABLE TO ANY APPEAL OF AN ASSESSMENT 8 FILED WITH A SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2014, THAT 9 IS STILL PENDING A FINAL DECISION ON THE APPEAL ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 10 2017.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2018.
