$\frac{1}{2}$	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16 17	(a) The Department shall establish a resident consolidated senior sport fishing license, to be issued to residents of Maryland beginning in the calendar year in which they attain the age of [65] 62 .
18	(b) (1) The resident consolidated senior sport fishing license may be obtained from the Department or from any authorized agent of the Department.
20	(2) (I) The annual fee for the license is \$5.
21 22	(II) As compensation FOR ISSUING A CONSOLIDATED SENIOR SPORT FISHING LICENSE, an agent shall retain 50 cents for each license issued.

- 1 (c) A resident consolidated senior sport fishing license shall be valid for 1 year 2 following the date of issuance.
- 3 (d) A holder of a resident consolidated senior sport fishing license may:
- 4 (1) Engage in angling on the nontidal waters of the State without holding 5 an angler's license under § 4–604 of this title;
- 6 (2) Engage in angling for trout on the nontidal waters of the State without 7 holding a trout stamp under § 4–614 of this title; and
- 8 (3) Fish for finfish in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries or in the State 9 waters of the Atlantic Ocean and the Atlantic coastal bays and their tributaries without 10 holding a Chesapeake Bay and coastal sport fishing license under § 4–745 of this title.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
