A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County – Superintendent of Schools – Appointment and**
3 **Reappointment**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the exemption of the Washington County Superintendent of
5 Schools and the Washington County Board of Education from certain requirements
6 that relate to the appointment and reappointment of the Superintendent; and
7 generally relating to the Washington County Superintendent of Schools.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

21 4–201.

22 (a) (1) This section does not apply to Baltimore City.

23 (2) Subsections (b), (c), (d), and (f) of this section do not apply in Prince
24 George’s County.

1 [(3) Subsections (b)(2) and (3) of this section do not apply in Washington
2 County.]

3 (b) (1) The term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1. A
4 county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

5 (2) By February 1 of the year in which a term ends, the county
6 superintendent shall notify the county board whether the superintendent is a candidate for
7 reappointment.

8 (3) In the year in which a term begins, the county board shall appoint a
9 county superintendent between February 1 and June 30. However, if the county board
10 decides to reappoint the incumbent superintendent, the county board shall take final action
11 at a public meeting no later than March 1 of that year.

12 (4) If a county board is unable to appoint a county superintendent by July
13 1 of a year in which a term begins, the provisions of subsection (d) of this section apply.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
15 1, 2018.
