2 Vehicle Laws - Civil Penalty for Failure to Pay Video Toll - Limitation

- FOR the purpose of establishing a certain civil penalty for a video toll violation; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to civil penalties for toll violations.

- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 Article – Transportation

- 14 (c) (1) Failure of the person alleged to be liable to pay the video toll under a notice of toll due by the date stated on the notice shall constitute a toll violation subject to a civil citation and a civil penalty **NOT EXCEEDING \$25**, which shall be assessed 15 days after the toll violation occurs, as provided for in the regulations of the Authority.
- 18 (2) A registered owner of a motor vehicle [shall] MAY not be liable for a civil penalty imposed under this section if the operator of the motor vehicle has been convicted of failure or refusal to pay a toll under § 21–1413 of this subtitle for the same violation.

- October 1, 2018.
