17 IF A COURT PASSES AN ORDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE IN 18 FAVOR OF THE PETITIONER ON THE GROUNDS OF INEFFECTIVENESS OF COUNSEL, 19 THE COURT SHALL REFER THE ATTORNEY WHOSE CONDUCT WAS FOUND 20 INEFFECTIVE TO THE ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMISSION FOR PROCEEDINGS IN 21 ACCORDANCE WITH THE MARYLAND RULES GOVERNING ATTORNEY DISCIPLINE.
