#### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Motor Vehicle Registration – Exception for Low Speed Electric Vehicles – City of Havre de Grace

4 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements  $\mathbf{5}$ under certain circumstances for low speed electric vehicles in the City of Havre de 6 Grace; providing that a person who operates a low speed electric vehicle on a highway 7 in the City of Havre de Grace may operate the low speed electric vehicle only on 8 certain roads at certain times and only if the low speed electric vehicle is equipped 9 with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a low speed electric vehicle on a highway in the City of Havre de Grace to keep as far to the right of the 1011 roadway as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the State 12Highway Administration, in consultation with the City of Havre de Grace, to develop 13 a location in the City of Havre de Grace where a person operating a low speed electric vehicle may cross over a certain highway; defining a certain term; and generally 14 15relating to an exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for low speed 16electric vehicles in the City of Havre de Grace.
