A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Community College - Eligibility of Students to Pay No Tuition or Fees

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain students residing in Somerset County may enroll full time in certain community colleges and pay no tuition or fees for a certain time $\mathbf{5}$ 6 if certain conditions are met; requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission 7 to pay 100% of in-county tuition and fees for certain eligible students from certain 8 funds and subject to certain conditions; requiring that certain student financial aid 9 be applied to pay an eligible student's tuition and fees before determining the amount 10 required to be paid by the Commission; requiring a student to repay funds spent on 11 the student's behalf to the Commission and county if the student is guilty of a felony; 12prohibiting a student from being eligible to pay no tuition or fees under this Act if 13the student is convicted of a felony; and generally relating to the eligibility of students residing in Somerset County to attend community college and pay no 14 15tuition or fees.

3 (b) (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of this subsection 4 and subsection (g) of this section, any student who attends a community college not 5 supported by the county in which the student resides shall pay, in addition to the student 6 tuition and fees payable by a resident of a county that supports the community college, an 7 out-of-county or out-of-region fee at least equal to 60% of the county share per full-time 8 equivalent student as determined under § 16–305 of this subtitle.

9 Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, if any student resides in (e) (1)a county where the per capita wealth is below the State average and the county does not 10 support a community college or a branch campus of a community college, except for 11 Baltimore City, the student may enroll at a community college or a branch campus in the 1213State, either of which is located in a county adjacent to the one in which the student resides, 14and pay only the tuition and fees applicable to a county resident that supports the 15community college.

16 (2) For any student determined to be eligible under paragraph (1) of this 17 subsection, the Commission shall pay:

(i) In fiscal year 1992, 75% of any applicable out-of-county fee
provided that the county in which the student resides pays 25 percent of that fee; and

(ii) In fiscal year 1993, and each fiscal year thereafter, 50% of any
applicable out-of-county fee provided that the county in which the student resides pays 50
percent of that fee.

(3) The Commission may make payments to effectuate the provisions of
