- 17 1. Except as provided in item [(ii)] 2 or [item (iii)] 3 of this
- [paragraph] ITEM, in the form of a removable windshield placard capable of being hung 18
- from the inside rearview mirror and of a size and design as determined by the 19

- 21 [(ii)] **2.** For a vehicle not equipped with an inside rearview mirror

- or in which the inside rearview mirror is not visible from the rear of the vehicle, in the form of a windshield placard of a size and design as determined by the Administration; or
- 3 [(iii)] **3.** For a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, in the form of a sticker of a size and design as designated by the Administration; **AND**
- 5 (II) INCLUDE ON ITS FACE A COLOR PHOTOGRAPH OF THE 6 PERSON TO WHOM THE PARKING PLACARD IS ISSUED THAT IS TAKEN IN 7 ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
