## A BILL ENTITLED

## Driver's Licenses and Identification Cards – Notation for Surviving Spouses of Veterans

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to ensure that the driver's 5 license or identification card of an applicant who presents certain proof that the 6 applicant is the surviving spouse of a veteran includes a notation indicating that 7 status; requiring an application for a driver's license or an identification card to allow 8 an applicant to indicate that the applicant is the surviving spouse of a veteran and 9 consents to being contacted by certain Executive Branch agencies under certain 10 circumstances for certain purposes; requiring the Administration to electronically 11 transmit certain information to certain Executive Branch agencies under certain 12 circumstances; authorizing the Administration to adopt regulations to carry out the 13 provisions of this Act; and generally relating to driver's licenses and identification 14 cards of surviving spouses of veterans.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 **12–302.1.**
- 24 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OR

- 1 IDENTIFICATION CARD OF AN APPLICANT WHO PRESENTS PROOF ACCEPTABLE TO
- 2 THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A
- 3 VETERAN INCLUDES A NOTATION INDICATING THAT STATUS.
- 4 (B) (1) AN APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR AN
- 5 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO INDICATE THAT THE
- 6 APPLICANT IS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A VETERAN AND CONSENTS TO BEING
- 7 CONTACTED BY APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES REGARDING THE
- 8 APPLICANT'S ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE OR FEDERAL BENEFITS AS THE SURVIVING
- 9 SPOUSE OF A VETERAN.
- 10 (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 4–304 THROUGH 4–325 OF THE
- 11 GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW, AND ON
- 12 REQUEST BY AN EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL
- 13 ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT TO THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY APPROPRIATE
- 14 INFORMATION ABOUT EACH APPLICANT WHO CONSENTS TO BEING CONTACTED IN
- 15 ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 16 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 17 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 19 October 1, 2018.
