Motor Vehicle Administration and Local Health Departments – Birth and Death Certificates – Issuance of Copies

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to access electronically 5 from the Maryland Department of Health a copy of a birth certificate or death 6 certificate; authorizing a local health department to access electronically from the 7 Department a copy of a death certificate; authorizing the Administration to provide 8 a copy of a birth certificate or death certificate to a certain person under certain 9 circumstances; authorizing a local health department to provide a copy of a death 10 certificate to a certain person under certain circumstances; authorizing the 11 Administration to set and collect a fee for processing and issuing a birth certificate 12 or death certificate or for a certain report; establishing requirements for certain fees collected by the Administration; providing for the distribution of certain fees 13 14 collected by the Administration; correcting an erroneous reference to a federal law; and generally relating to the issuance of copies of birth certificates and death 15 certificates. 16

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article - Health - General 4-217. 4 Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Secretary shall 5 (a) (1) 6 provide, on request, any person authorized by regulations adopted under this subtitle with 7 a certified or abridged copy of a birth, death, or fetal death certificate registered under this subtitle or of the certificate of a marriage performed after June 1, 1951. 8 9 Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a local health department OR THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION may: 10 11 Access electronically from the Department a certified or abridged (i) 12 copy of a birth certificate OR DEATH CERTIFICATE registered under this subtitle; and 13 (ii) On request, provide any person authorized by regulations 14 adopted under this subtitle with a certified or abridged copy of a birth certificate OR DEATH **CERTIFICATE** registered under this subtitle. 15 16 The Secretary shall provide on request, to any person authorized 17 by regulation adopted under this subtitle, a commemorative birth certificate. 18 (ii) The Department shall set a fee for the commemorative birth certificate. 19 The commemorative birth certificate shall: 20 (iii) 211. Be in a form consistent with the need to protect the 22 integrity of vital records but suitable for display; and 23 2. Have the same status as evidence as the original birth 24certificate. 25 (iv) A portion of the funds collected under this paragraph shall go to 26 the Department for the production costs of issuing the commemorative birth certificates. 27 The remainder of the funds collected shall be paid into the Children's Trust Fund 28 established under § 13–2207 of this article to provide funding for the Child Abuse Medical Providers (Maryland CHAMP) Initiative.
