There is a Deep Creek Lake Policy and Review Board. 1 (a) 2 (b) (1) The Board consists of: 3 Five members appointed by the Governor in accordance with paragraph (2) of this subsection; 4 The Senator of the Maryland General Assembly who represents 5 (ii) 6 legislative district 1 or the Senator's designee; 7 (iii) The Delegate of the Maryland General Assembly who represents delegate district 1A of legislative district 1 or the Delegate's designee; 8 9 A member of the Board of County Commissioners of Garrett (iv) County, selected by the Board of County Commissioners, or an alternative County 10 11 Commissioner, serving as the member's designee; 12 The president of the Deep Creek Lake property owner's (v) association or the president's designee; [and] 13 14 The chairman of the Garrett County Chamber of Commerce or (vi) the chairman's designee; AND 15 16 (VII) THE FOLLOWING NONVOTING EX OFFICIO MEMBERS: 1.
