2 **Talbot County Board of Education – Start Date of Term for Members**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date for the start of the term for a member elected to serve
4 on the Talbot County Board of Education; and generally relating to the date for the
5 start of the term for members elected to the Talbot County Board of Education.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 3–12A–01.

1 (a) The Talbot County Board consists of:

2 (1) Seven voting members, one member elected from each of the seven
3 election districts for the county board established in accordance with this subtitle; and

4 (2) Two nonvoting student members from the public high schools in the
5 county.

6 (b) The elected members of the county board shall be elected:

7 (1) At the general election; and

8 (2) In accordance with Title 8, Subtitle 8 of the Election Law Article.

9 (e) (1) Each voting member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on
10 [January] **DECEMBER** 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and
11 qualifies.

12 (2) A voting member may not serve for more than three consecutive terms.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2018.
