BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 7-125.(A) THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP CURRICULUM CONTENT FOR A SEMESTER-LONG HIGH SCHOOL ELECTIVE COURSE IN FINANCIAL LITERACY AND
