A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Park Heights Redevelopment Area – Alcoholic Beverages –**
3 **Store Closing Time**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the time during which establishments for which certain
5 alcoholic beverages licenses are issued in the Park Heights Redevelopment Area in
6 Baltimore City may sell alcoholic beverages; and generally relating to the sale of
7 alcoholic beverages in Baltimore City.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

21 12–102.

22 This title applies only in Baltimore City.

23 12–2003.

1 (a) (1) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class A
2 beer and light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

3 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

4 1. from 9 a.m. to **[midnight] 10 P.M.** in the Park Heights
5 Redevelopment Area that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by the City
6 in 2006; and

7 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;
8 and

9 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
10 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
11 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$75 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
12 exercised.

13 12–2004.

14 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class A beer,
15 wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

16 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

17 1. from 9 a.m. to **[midnight] 10 P.M.** in the Park Heights
18 Redevelopment Area that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by the City
19 in 2006; and

20 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;
21 and

22 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
23 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
24 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$75 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
25 exercised.

26 (c) Except as provided in § 12–2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B–D–7
27 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

28 (1) from 9 a.m. to **[2 a.m. the following day] 10 P.M.** in the Park Heights
29 Redevelopment Area that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by the City
30 in 2006; and

31 (2) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
33 1, 2018.
