1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Procurement – Security Requirements – Forms**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt regulations to establish
4 certain forms for procurement officers to use to require security for construction
5 contracts and contracts for certain supplies and services; requiring that a certain
6 form provide for annual and renewable contracts; and generally relating to security
7 requirements and procurement.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

16 13–216.

17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a procurement officer may
18 not require a contractor to provide a performance bond, payment bond, or other security on
19 a procurement contract for construction, construction related services, services, or supplies
20 if the price of the procurement contract is \$100,000 or less.

1 (b) A procurement officer shall require a contractor to provide a performance
2 bond, payment bond, or other security if federal law or a condition of federal assistance
3 requires the security.

4 (c) If the price of a procurement contract for construction exceeds \$100,000, a
5 procurement officer shall require a contractor to provide security as required under Title
6 17, Subtitle 1 of this article.

7 (d) A procurement officer may require a contractor to provide a performance bond
8 or other security on a procurement contract for supplies, services, or construction related
9 services if:

10 (1) circumstances warrant security; and

11 (2) the price of the procurement contract exceeds \$100,000.

12 **(E) (1) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH**
13 **SEPARATE FORMS FOR PROCUREMENT OFFICERS TO USE TO REQUIRE SECURITY**
14 **FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS AND CONTRACTS FOR SUPPLIES, SERVICES, OR**
15 **CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES.**

16 **(2) THE FORM FOR CONTRACTS FOR SUPPLIES, SERVICES, OR**
17 **CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE FOR ANNUAL AND RENEWABLE**
18 **CONTRACTS.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2018.
