17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a procurement officer may 18 not require a contractor to provide a performance bond, payment bond, or other security on 19 a procurement contract for construction, construction related services, services, or supplies 20 if the price of the procurement contract is \$100,000 or less.

21 (b) A procurement officer shall require a contractor to provide a performance 22 bond, payment bond, or other security if federal law or a condition of federal assistance 23 requires the security.

8 (E) (1) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH 9 SEPARATE FORMS FOR PROCUREMENT OFFICERS TO USE TO REQUIRE SECURITY 10 FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS AND CONTRACTS FOR SUPPLIES, SERVICES, OR 11 CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES.

12 (2) THE FORM FOR CONTRACTS FOR SUPPLIES, SERVICES, OR 13 CONSTRUCTION RELATED SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE FOR ANNUAL AND RENEWABLE 14 CONTRACTS.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2018.
