- 17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a procurement officer may 18 not require a contractor to provide a performance bond, payment bond, or other security on 19 a procurement contract for construction, construction related services, services, or supplies
- 20 if the price of the procurement contract is \$100,000 or less.
