 fluorescent pink outerwear while hunting.

- 8 (v) Wild turkeys.

9 (b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this section, a person who hunts any 10 wildlife and a person who accompanies, aids, or assists another person in a field, wooded 11 area, marsh, or on the water to hunt any wildlife shall wear:

12 (1) A cap of a solid daylight fluorescent orange OR DAYLIGHT 13 FLUORESCENT PINK color;

14 (2) A vest, jacket, or jacket containing back and front panels of at least 250 15 square inches of a solid daylight fluorescent orange **OR DAYLIGHT FLUORESCENT PINK** 16 color; or

17 (3) An outer garment of camouflage fluorescent orange OR PINK worn
 18 above the waist which contains at least 50 percent daylight fluorescent orange OR
 19 DAYLIGHT FLUORESCENT PINK color.

20 (c) By regulation, the Department may define the [term "daylight] TERMS:

21 (1) "DAYLIGHT fluorescent orange" consistent with the recommendations 22 of the North American Association of Hunter Safety Coordinators; AND

23 (2) "DAYLIGHT FLUORESCENT PINK".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2018.
