### CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County – Fire Companies – Appropriations**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the County Commissioners of Somerset County to  
4 appropriate to certain organized volunteer fire companies in the county certain  
5 amounts for certain fiscal years; requiring that the appropriations required for a  
6 certain fiscal year remain in effect for subsequent fiscal years unless altered by a  
7 future enactment; and generally relating to appropriations for organized volunteer  
8 fire companies in Somerset County.
