Voter Registration Integrity Act of 2018

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a jury commissioner to provide certain prospective juror 4 information concerning individuals who are not citizens of the United States to the 5 State Board of Elections within a certain time period; requiring the State 6 Administrator of Elections to make certain arrangements to receive the information; 7 requiring the State Administrator to retain a list of certain individuals whose 8 information has been submitted; requiring the State Administrator, within a certain 9 period of time, to direct a certain election director to remove a certain individual from 10 the statewide voter registration list; requiring the State Administrator to publish 11 annually certain information on the State Board's website; requiring each election 12 director to remove certain individuals from the statewide voter registration list and 13 submit a certain quarterly report to the State Administrator; and generally relating to the disclosure and use of juror information for the purpose of maintaining the 14 15 statewide voter registration list.

- 3 (a) A custodian, as defined in § 4–101(d) of the General Provisions Article, may 4 allow access to information about prospective, qualified, and sworn jurors only in 5 accordance with rules that the Court of Appeals adopts.
- 6 (b) The rules shall provide for access to, and copying of, information needed for a 7 challenge under § 8–408 or § 8–409 of this title.
