BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 15 38-104. 16 17 [This] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, 18 **THIS** section applies to an individual who is: 19 (i) a member of a State system; or 20 a former member of a State system who is eligible to receive a (ii) benefit under § 29–302 or § 29–303 of this article. 21

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July

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1, 2018.
