- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain applicant or licensee is subject to a certain minority business participation goal established for a unit by the Special Secretary 5 6 for the Office of Small, Minority, and Women Business Affairs under certain 7 provisions of law; requiring that a certain minority business participation goal 8 applies to certain construction and procurement related to video lottery terminals; 9 altering the termination date for certain provisions of law concerning minority 10 business participation for certain construction and procurement related to video 11 lottery terminals; and generally relating to video lottery terminals and minority 12 business participation.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 18
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 For the construction and procurement, including the procurement of 23 equipment and ongoing services, related to the operation of video lottery terminals, the 24
- applicant or licensee shall at a minimum meet the same requirements of a designated unit
