- 7 (4) sell at retail on the premises of the Class D or Class B license, for 8 on–sale or off–sale consumption, more than [15,500] **35,000** gallons of the products 9 manufactured under the license each calendar year; and
- 10 (5) own, operate, or be affiliated in any manner with another 11 manufacturer.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
