## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Alcoholic Beverages - Class 5 Breweries - Sales of Beer for On-Premises Consumption

FOR the purpose of altering the number of barrels of beer that certain holders of Class 5 brewery licenses may sell in a single year for on-premises consumption; repealing a requirement that a holder of a Class 5 brewery license purchase certain barrels of beer from a licensed wholesaler before selling them for on-premises consumption; and generally relating to holders of Class 5 brewery licenses.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article - Alcoholic Beverages Section 2-207(b) and (f)(4) Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2017 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Alcoholic Beverages Section 2-207(f)(5)
Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2017 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Alcoholic Beverages

(b) There is a Class 5 brewery license.
(f) (4) Except as provided in paragraph (5) of this subsection, the total amount

1 of beer sold each year for on-premises consumption under this subsection may not exceed 2 2,000 barrels.
(5) (i) If, in a single year, the license holder reaches $80 \%$ of the volume authorized to be sold for on-premises consumption under paragraph (4) of this subsection, the license holder may file a request with the Comptroller for permission to sell [up to an] additional $[1,000]$ barrels for on-premises consumption in that year.
(ii) The maximum volume that a license holder may sell for on-premises consumption in a single year is:

1. 3,000 barrels, FOR A LICENSE HOLDER THAT BREWS 100,000 BARRELS OR LESS IN A SINGLE YEAR; OR
2. 3,000 BARRELS PLUS $1 \%$ OF THE NUMBER OF BARRELS BREWED OVER 100,000, FOR A LICENSE HOLDER THAT BREWS MORE THAN 100,000 BARRELS IN A SINGLE YEAR.
[(iii) Any beer that the license holder sells for on-premises consumption in excess of the 2,000-barrel limit under paragraph (4) of this subsection shall be purchased from a licensed wholesaler.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
