## Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Wine <u>License Privilege</u> - Cheese and Deli Shops

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a cheese and deli shop wine license privilege in Frederick 5 County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the <del>license</del> 6 privilege for use by an establishment for which a certain license has been issued that 7 derives a certain percentage of its total average daily receipts from the sale of cheese, 8 meats, sandwiches, and other products normally associated with delis; authorizing 9 the holder of the <del>license</del> privilege to <del>provide</del> sell wine by the glass for 10 on-premises consumption while the customer is purchasing items at the cheese and 11 deli shop or attending a certain event; prohibiting the license from being transferred 12 to another location; specifying that the license privilege may be exercised during 13 certain hours; providing that an establishment for which the license privilege is 14 issued is subject to certain alcohol awareness training requirements; specifying an 15 annual license privilege fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in 16 Frederick County.
