3 FOR the purpose of providing that when an appointing authority of a unit in the State 4 Personnel Management System appoints an employee to a position in the skilled service or the professional service, the Secretary of Budget and Management shall 5 6 require that a certain adjustment be made in the pay rate of certain incumbent 7 employees in the unit; providing that the Secretary is not required to make a certain 8 adjustment of certain pay rates for certain incumbent employees under certain 9 circumstances; requiring the Secretary of Transportation to prepare and recommend 10 a standard pay plan for the human resources management system that conforms with certain provisions of this Act; making stylistic changes requiring the 11 Department of Budget and Management, in consultation with the Maryland 12 Department of Transportation, to submit to certain committees of the General 13 Assembly on or before a certain date a report outlining a certain plan and identifying 14 15 certain information; and generally relating to pay rates of State employees in the same classification. 16
