CHAPTER

AN ACT concerning 1

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Estates and Trusts - Administration of Estates - Waiver of Fees

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the registers a register of wills to waive certain fees for the 4 administration of an estate if certain real property subject to administration in this State is to be transferred to a certain individual or is encumbered by a lien and subject to sale under certain provisions of law, and the estate is unable to pay the fees by reason of poverty; providing for the prospective application of this Act; and generally relating to fees for estate administration.
