A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Joint Committee on Election Oversight – Establishment

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Joint Committee on Election Oversight; providing for the membership and staffing of the Committee; providing that members of the 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Committee serve at the pleasure of the appointing officer; providing for the 6 appointment of cochairs of the Committee; providing that a majority of the full 7 authorized membership of the Committee is a quorum; establishing the powers and 8 duties of the Committee; requiring the Committee to submit a certain report to the 9 General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; and generally relating to the Joint Committee on Election Oversight. 10

2 (1) STUDY THE BUDGETS, PROGRAMS, AND POLICIES OF THE STATE 3 BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND THE LOCAL BOARDS OF ELECTIONS TO DETERMINE 4 WAYS IN WHICH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY IMPROVE ELECTION 5 ADMINISTRATION AND CAMPAIGN FINANCE REGULATION;

6 (2) EXAMINE ELECTION STATUTES AND COURT DECISIONS TO
7 DETERMINE ANY LEGISLATIVE CHANGES THAT ARE NEEDED TO IMPROVE ELECTION
8 ADMINISTRATION AND CAMPAIGN FINANCE REGULATION;

9 (3) STUDY INITIATIVES IN OTHER STATES REGARDING ELECTION 10 ADMINISTRATION AND CAMPAIGN FINANCE REGULATION TO PROVIDE AN ONGOING 11 COMMENTARY TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE INITIATIVES AND TO MAKE 12 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING SIMILAR INITIATIVES IN THE STATE;

13 (4) IDENTIFY NEW LAWS, REGULATIONS, PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND
 14 BUDGETARY PRIORITIES TO IMPROVE ELECTION ADMINISTRATION AND CAMPAIGN
 15 FINANCE REGULATION IN THE STATE; AND

16 (5) STUDY ANY OTHER ELECTION MATTERS THAT THE COMMITTEE 17 CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO FULFILL ITS MANDATE.

18 (J) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR AND SUBJECT TO § 19 2–1246 OF THIS TITLE, THE COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL 20 ASSEMBLY THAT INCLUDES:

- 21 (1) A DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEE; AND
- 22 (2) ANY RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2018.
