CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State House Trust – Duties – Maintenance of Lawyer’s Mall**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State House Trust to be responsible for the maintenance,
4 including any related construction, of Lawyer’s Mall; requiring the Trust to
5 disapprove or approve and supervise any proposed repair, improvement, or other
6 change to Lawyer’s Mall; providing that the Trust is not required under certain
7 provisions of this Act to be responsible for, or disapprove or approve and supervise,
8 the coordination, security, and scheduling of rallies and other events held on
9 Lawyer’s Mall; and generally relating to the duties of the State House Trust.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Government**

18 9–505.

19 **(A)** In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Trust shall:

1 (1) be responsible for the restoration and preservation of the State House;
2 [and]

3 (2) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE, INCLUDING ANY
4 RELATED CONSTRUCTION, OF LAWYER’S MALL; AND

5 [(2)] (3) disapprove or approve and supervise:

6 (i) any proposed repair, improvement, or other change to the State
7 House or to any other building within State Circle, including any change to the furnishings
8 or fixtures of those buildings; [and]

9 (ii) any proposed landscaping of the grounds of those buildings; AND

10 (III) ANY PROPOSED REPAIR, IMPROVEMENT, OR OTHER
11 CHANGE TO LAWYER’S MALL.

12 (B) THE TRUST IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(2) OR (3)(III) OF
13 THIS SECTION TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR DISAPPROVE OR APPROVE AND
14 SUPERVISE, THE COORDINATION, SECURITY, AND SCHEDULING OF RALLIES AND
15 OTHER EVENTS HELD ON LAWYER’S MALL.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2018.
