SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

> Article - Education

4-111.
(A) IN THIS SECTION, "NO-ZERO GRADING POLICY" MEANS A GRADING POLICY THAT DOES NOT ALLOW A TEACHER TO ISSUE A ZERO.
[(a)] (B) Subject to the applicable provisions of this article and the bylaws, basic policies, and guidelines established by the State Board, each county board, on the written recommendation of the county superintendent, shall:
(1) Establish curriculum guides and courses of study for the schools under its jurisdiction, including appropriate programs of instruction or training for mentally or physically handicapped children; and
