SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

14 2-504.

(a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not more than
[\$114,500] \$124,500 as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the relative volume
of business and receipts in the clerk's office.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 19 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 20 or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court while serving in a term of office beginning 21 before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or 22 compensation of the clerk of a circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the next 23 following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected 24 after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
