### **SENATE BILL 671**

1 (a) Except as provided in [subsection (b)] SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) of this 2 section, a person who violates this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is 3 subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both.

## 4 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON 5 WHO VIOLATES § 10–302, § 10–303, § 10–304, OR § 10–305 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS 6 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT 7 NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.

8 [(b)] (C) (1) A person who violates § 10–304(2)(i) of this subtitle is guilty of a 9 felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or a fine not 10 exceeding \$10,000 or both.

11 (2) A person who violates § 10–304(2)(ii) of this subtitle is guilty of a felony 12 and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 20 years or a fine not exceeding 13 \$20,000 or both.

(D) AS A CONDITION OF SUPERVISED RELEASE, A COURT MAY REQUIRE A
PERSON CONVICTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO ATTEND EDUCATIONAL CLASSES
AND PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE RELATED TO THE PERSON OR GROUP OF A
PARTICULAR RACE, COLOR, RELIGIOUS BELIEF, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER,
DISABILITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, OR STATUS AS HOMELESS THAT WAS THE SUBJECT
OF THE PERSON'S VIOLATION.

Nothing in this subtitle may be construed to infringe on the speech of a religious leader or other individual during peaceable activity intended to express the leader's or individual's religious beliefs or convictions.
