- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Public Utilities

17 (b) (3) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, unless a 18 certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction is first obtained from the 19 Commission, a person may not begin construction of an overhead transmission line that is 20 designed to carry a voltage in excess of 69,000 volts or exercise a right of condemnation 21 with the construction.

(ii) For construction related to an existing overhead transmission
 line, the Commission may waive the requirement in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph for
 good cause.

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1 (iii) Notwithstanding subparagraph (i) of this paragraph and subject $\mathbf{2}$ to subparagraph (iv) of this paragraph, the Commission may issue a certificate of public 3 convenience and necessity for the construction of an overhead transmission line only if the 4 applicant for the certificate of public convenience and necessity: $\mathbf{5}$ 1. is an electric company; or 6 is or, on the start of commercial operation of the overhead 2. 7transmission line, will be subject to regulation as a public utility by an officer or an agency 8 of the United States. 9 (iv) The Commission may not issue a certificate of public convenience 10 and necessity for the construction of an overhead transmission line in the electric 11 distribution service territory of an electric company to an applicant other than an electric 12company if: 131. the overhead transmission line is to be located solely 14within the electric distribution service territory of that electric company; and 152.the cost of the overhead transmission line is to be paid solely by that electric company and its ratepayers. 1617This subparagraph applies to the construction of an (v) 1. overhead transmission line for which a certificate of public convenience and necessity is 18 19required under this section. 2.20On issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction of an overhead transmission line, a person may acquire by 2122condemnation, in accordance with Title 12 of the Real Property Article AND SUBJECT TO 23APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSION, any property or right necessary for the construction or 24maintenance of the transmission line.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2018.

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
