11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13	Article - Local Government
14	4–108.
15	(a) A qualified voter may vote in a municipal election by absentee ballot.
16 17	(b) (1) [A] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A municipality shall provide a procedure to vote by absentee ballot.

- **(2)** A MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL TO PROVIDE 19 A REASON THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WILL BE UNABLE TO VOTE IN PERSON ON
- 20 ELECTION DAY IN ORDER TO VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT.

21 A municipality may use any method to enable absentee voters to vote, 22 including using any facilities to transmit and receive applications for absentee ballots.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2018.
