SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Article Local Government
 4–108.
 (a) A qualified voter may vote in a municipal election by absentee ballot.
 (b) (1) [A] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
 municipality shall provide a procedure to vote by absentee ballot.
- 18 (2) A MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL TO PROVIDE

3 (c) A municipality may use any method to enable absentee voters to vote, 4 including using any facilities to transmit and receive applications for absentee ballots.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 6 1, 2018.
