1 AN ACT concerning

Pensions – Administrative and Operational Expenses – Limitation and Calculation

FOR the purpose of increasing the administrative and operational expense cap of the Board
of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System and the State Retirement
Agency in certain fiscal years under certain circumstances; altering the basis for the
calculation of the administrative and operational expense cap; providing for the
application of this Act; making certain sections of this Act contingent on the taking
effect of another Act; and generally relating to the administrative and operational
expense cap for the Board of Trustees and the Agency.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 21–315.

SUBSECTION, EACH year the Board of Trustees shall estimate the amount, not exceeding

15 (c) Each year the Board of Trustees shall estimate the amount, not exceeding 16 0.22% of [the payroll of members] ACTIVE MEMBER PAYROLL, RETIREE BENEFITS, AND 17 FORMER MEMBER COMPENSATION, necessary for the administrative and operational 18 expenses of the Board of Trustees and the State Retirement Agency.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take
effect July 1, 2018, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ____ (S.B. __/H.B.
___)(8lr1668/8lr1669) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2018, and if Chapter ____ (S.B.
___ / H.B. ___)(8lr1668/8lr1669) does not take effect, Section 2 of this Act, with no further
action required by the General Assembly, shall be null and void.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if Section 2 of this Act takes
 effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by
 the General Assembly.

27 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of 28 Sections 3 and 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
