11 (L) AT LEAST ONE TIME EACH YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE 12 TO A CHILD IN AN OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT WHO IS AT LEAST 13 YEARS OLD 13 INFORMATION REGARDING THE RIGHTS OF A CHILD IN AN OUT-OF-HOME 14 PLACEMENT.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2018.

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
