A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Educational Excellence Award Eligibility – High School**
3 **Diploma by Examination**

4 FOR the purpose of specifying that a certain requirement to obtain a high school diploma
5 shall be satisfied if a certain individual has obtained a high school diploma by
6 examination; and generally relating to the eligibility for a Delegate Howard P.
7 Rawlings Educational Excellence Award.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 (a) There is a Delegate Howard P. Rawlings Program of Educational Excellence
23 Awards in this State that are awarded under this subtitle.

2 **A REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA**
3 **SHALL BE SATISFIED IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS SUCCESSFULLY OBTAINED A HIGH**
4 **SCHOOL DIPLOMA BY EXAMINATION UNDER § 11-808 OF THE LABOR AND**
5 **EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2018.
