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## Insurance – Commercial Lines – Exemptions From Filings

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain requirements to the Maryland Insurance Commissioner for filing with the Commissioner certain rates and supplementary 4  $\mathbf{5}$ rate information and for modifications of rates and supplementary rate information 6 do not apply to exempt commercial policyholders; <del>repeals</del> repealing the requirement 7 that a certain commercial policyholder has to certify in a certain manner to the 8 Commissioner that it meets certain criteria for a certain exemption; altering the 9 definition of "exempt commercial policyholder"; and generally relating to exemptions 10 from rate and form filings for commercial insurance lines.

# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
